



EXPANDABLE SHORELINE THE EMBARCADERO

The expandable shoreline is an urban design initiative. It allows for population expansion while providing protection from rising sea levels. The proposed intervention is comprised of buildings, parks, boating docks, and performance spaces. The flexible and interchangeable structural bays allow for uninhibited vertical and horizontal expansion. In San Francisco, this linear intervention would weave around the historical Embarcadero to protect against inundation. Thus giving opportunity to create a new and unprecedented urban neighborhood along the waterfront.
